6.2. The Supplier does not guarantee an uninterrupted supply of electricity and shall not be liable for any damage, direct or indirect, resulting from interruptions, voltage fluctuations, or phase failures, except where caused by the Supplier's gross negligence.

7. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION
